


#### TINATIONS REPORT SNAPSHOT

Of the 499 Economics majors who graduated, data is available for 397. Of this number 78% accepted employment, 19% were attending graduate school, 3% were still looking, and .2% were volunteering.






# CLASS OF 2021 SURVEY RESPONSE STATISTICS














## Offer/Accept Timeline
